The Princess Di stuff...I am the most sad for her sons. I think it is tragic what happened. There are a lot of people who are very upset by this whole incident. I'm sorry you're having a hard time with it. As i said, i feel bad for her kids and sorry that she passed away, but i wasn't really her biggest fan -- sort of neutral towards her.

Well, I have an update or maybe an end-date... it's kinda long so here goes...

Yesterday morning i went to a farewell ceremony for someone here and saw the White House liaison woman with whom I met last week about being detailed. I asked her if she got my e-mail and she said she had and asked if i had spoken to Marsha recently. I said "no. why?" She said that marsha had run into a few snags and i should talk to her. So i called marsha all day long yetserday and finally got in touch with her at 5 pm. She has been stripped of the detailee slot in her office. So for now, there isn't anyplace for me to be detailed. So I should be PATIENT. I told her i was very upset and disappointed (even though i really didn't want to work for her) and then she and i got into it. She didn't understand why i wanted to come back when there were still people there who would give me a hard time and that it isn't the right political climate for me to come back. I said i din't understand why it was okay for there to be talk about some people there but it wasn't okay for me. they have all been taken care of. ohhhh it was so infuriating. she asked me why i kept pushing the envelope on coming back there -- after all i had the experience of being there already!

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So it's over. I don't know what i will do now but i can't wait any more and i can't go through all of this crap anymore. In some ways i hope i never hear from him again because he'll just lead me on because he doesn't have the balls to tell me the truth. I kind of phase in and out of being sad -- as to be expected but i'll survive. What other choice do i have?
